To add to the variety of events, visitors are invited to practice yoga on the beach with Rio Halifax or take part in a boot camp with Crossfit Ironstone. For those who want to paddle to the picnic, Our HRM Alliance is launching "Hike the Greenbelt" at our picnic by paddling over from Point Pleasant Park.

Visitors should pack a picnic lunch, bring plenty of water, wear comfortable footwear and dress for the weather. For those going on the inter-tidal walk, be prepared to get your feet wet.
