ABC:	Develop Nova Scotia Limited, Board of Directors
Department:	Inclusive Economic Growth
Objectives:	Align with and further the strategic economic policy objectives and priorities of the Government and, in doing so, lead the implementation of the Government's strategy to expand telecommunications infrastructure to enable access to global information and communication networks throughout the Province; develop and implement economic infrastructure strategies and place-making strategies; acquire, hold, improve, develop, whether directly or in partnership with the private sector, strategic economic infrastructure, to promote place-making; provide services relating to and promote the development of strategic economic infrastructure throughout the Province; communicate and collaborate with communities, municipalities, the private sector and others to promote place-making.
ABC Type:	Non-Adjudicative
Composition:	The Board consists of not less than seven and not more than 15 members appointed by the Governor in Council. The Deputy Minister of Business may attend meetings of the Board but is not a member of the Board.

Remuneration:	Chair: \$150 per day, plus expenses; Vice Chair: \$150 per day, plus expenses; Members: \$150 per day, plus expenses.
Term:	Members may serve only two consecutive terms; each term may be up to four years. Where a person has served two terms on the Board, the person may not be appointed to the Board again until four years after that person's last term ends.
Meeting Location:	The Board meets in the offices of Develop Nova Scotia, Suite 301, 1875 Upper Water Street, Halifax.
Meeting Frequency:	The Board meets quarterly. A 6-8 hour quarterly time commitment is required.
