Subject to the Nova Scotia Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, all matters discussed at Develop Nova Scotia Board meetings are confidential and are not to be disclosed to anyone outside DNS's Board of Directors.

Directors should; however, feel free to promote and support DNS activities that they know are already in the public domain (e.g. via press releases, advertising, etc.)

In addition, as a means of assisting Directors with their "cheerleader" function, the Board may, at the end of each Board meeting, agree upon certain key messages that Directors can talk about publicly.
